

**Village of Barons
Bylaw No. 741**

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BARONS IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING BYLAW #705 AND TO REPEAL BYLAWS #699 AND #690, THE VILLAGE OF BARONS TRAFFIC BYLAW.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 7(d) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, current as of June 17, 2021, Council may pass bylaws as well as designate authority with respect to streets under its direction, control and management;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 13(1) of the Traffic Safety Act, being Chapter T-6 of the revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, authorizes a municipality to regulate and control of vehicle traffic as well as parking on streets and property within the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of the Village of Barons, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Part 13 of the Traffic Bylaw #705 be amended by adding as follows:
 7. No person shall park any vehicle, recreation vehicle or trailer in their front yard other than on their driveway.
2. Bylaw No. 705, being the Traffic Bylaw is hereby amended.
3. Upon third reading of Bylaw #741, Bylaws #699 and #690 and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed.

Effective Date

This Bylaw shall come into effect after the third reading and upon being signed.
